**CHESS INDIA**

Rules & Regulations

1. System of Play: The tournament will be conducted under the FIDE Swiss System in accordance with the FIDE Rapid Chess Regulations.
2. Time Control: 10 minutes + 5 seconds increment per move from move 1.
3. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the latest FIDE Laws of Chess.
4. Tie-break: Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn-Berger, Direct Encounter, Number of Wins (including wins by forfeit), and Number of Wins with Black.
5. Eligibility: The tournament is open to all players, irrespective of district or state.
6. The use of any electronic device, including any type of wristwatch, is strictly prohibited in the playing venue and may result in the loss of the game.
7. AICF Registration: An active AICF registration (for the year 2026-2027) is compulsory for all Indian players.
8. Players who have applied for AICF registration but whose status is not yet shown as Active must submit a copy of the payment receipt along with their registration details.
9. Kerala Players: AICF registration for the year 2026-2027 and CAK registration for 2026 are compulsory.
10. It is the responsibility of each player to ensure that their AICF and CAK registrations (for Kerala players) are valid before the commencement of the tournament. The organizer shall not be responsible for late fees or invalid registrations.
11. Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee will be constituted during the Technical Meeting.
12. Protests: Any protest against an arbiter's decision must be submitted in writing within 10 minutes of the incident, along with a protest fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only). The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding.
13. Interpretation of Rules: The Tournament Committee shall have the final authority to interpret these rules and to decide any matter not covered by them.
14. Withdrawal: A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage by informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
15. Age Proof: Players competing for category prizes must produce valid proof of date of birth if requested by the organizer.
16. Prize money of Rs. 10,000/- and above will be transferred to the winners within 7 working days after the tournament.
17. The organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason.
18. The organizer reserves the right to modify the event schedule or regulations at any time.
19. The organizer shall not be responsible for players' accommodation, travel, transportation, or any other personal arrangements. Participants must make their own arrangements.
20. Spot entries will not be accepted.
